About Our College

The Dharmamurthi Rao Bahadur Calavala Cunnan Chetty's Hindu College was started in the year 1969 at Pattabiram, a semi - urban area of Chennai, to commemorate the Birth Centenary of our illustrious Founder, Dharmamurthi Rao Bahadur Calavala Cunnan Chetty Garu whose philanthropic services were praised by Dr. Annie Besant and Mahakavi Bharathiar.

The College functions under the philanthropic management of Dharmamurthi Rao Bahadur Calavala Cunnan Chetty's Charities. To cater to the ever growing demand for higher education, Evening College (Shift 2 - Self Financing) was started in the same campus in 1995. The college is situated in the Avadi Corporation area on the Chennai - Tiruvallur High Road. The College is privileged to have a Railway Station in its name just across the highway.

The College is co-educational, affiliated to the University of Madras and has highly qualified and experienced Faculty providing a realistic and practical educational experience to the students.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY FOR UNDER - GRADUATE COURSES

Applicant must have passed the Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Course or an equivalent examination recognised by the University of Madras.

B.A. Historical Studies

Applicant should have studied History or any other subject in the qualifying examination. Preference shall be given to the applicants who have studied the subject concerned.

B.A. Economics

Applicant should have studied Economics/Mathematics or any other subjects in the qualifying examination. Preference shall be given to the applicants who have studied the subject concerned.

B.A. English & B.A. Telugu

Applicant should have studied English Language for English Literature and Telugu Language for Telugu Literature under part - I language or an advanced language subject in the qualifying examination.

B.Sc. Mathematics

Applicant should have studied Mathematics in the qualifying examination.

B.Com. General & B.Com. Corporate Secretaryship

Applicant should have studied Commerce / Accountancy / related vocational subjects in the qualifying examination.

COURSE FEE

The prescribed course fee is **Rs.770/-** for each course. Students from CBSE / Other States must pay **Rs.100/-** in addition to prescribed fee.

APPLICATION FORMS & PROSPECTUS

Application Forms & Prospectus can be obtained from the College Office or the Office of the Charities at No.116, Govindappa Naicken Street, Chennai - 600 001, on payment of Rs. 50/- in cash (Rs. 48/- for application & Rs.2/- for registration). The students who belong to SC/SCA/ST are exempted from the payment of application fee of Rs.48/- on submission of photo copy of E-community Certificate. LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

The applicants are advised to submit the filled in application at the College Office as early as possible without waiting for the last date. However, the last date for submission of applications shall normally be 10 working days from the date of publication of the results of Higher Secondary (+2) examinations of Tamil Nadu Government.

General Instructions

- i) The applicants should ensure that correct details are furnished in the application. Furnishing false information would result in forfeiture of admission in addition to initiating legal action.
- ii) In the application, the applicant must affix his/her passport size photograph taken within a period of 3 months prior to the date of submission of the application form.
- iii) The applicants are advised to keep with them, attested photocopies of their certificates as they may need them for future use.
- iv) Claiming the community of BC/BC(M)/MBC/DNC/SC/SC (Arunthathiyar)/ST by the candidates at a later date after the submission of the application will not be considered under any circumstances.
- v) The caste mentioned in the Transfer Certificate must match with the Community Certificate.
- vi) There shall be a minimum gap of 2 years between the date of passing S.S.L.C. (X Std.) Examination and the Higher Secondary Examination (Plus Two).
- vii) The upper age limit for admission to UG courses will be 21 (twenty one) years as on 1st July 2023. However, a relaxation of 5 years is permitted for Differently Abled candidates (Men & Women).

 BC/BC(M)/MBC/DNC/SC/SC(A)/ST candidates, and women candidates are allowed the age relaxation of 3 years beyond 21 years.
- viii) Admission is subject to verification of marks statement by the Directorate of Government Examinations.

 If the statement of marks certificate is found to be bogus, admission will be cancelled and criminal action will be taken.
- ix) The parents must be present with the student at the time of admission.
- x) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

Admission Procedure

All the eligible applications will be ranked strictly according to the marks secured in the qualifying examination, as per the admission guidelines of the Government.

Reservation

The rule of reservation for Admission applicable to Minority Institutions as prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu will be strictly followed.
