Application form & prospectus can be obtained from our college office by paying Application fee.

What is the cost of Application Form (UG & PG) ?

Cost of each application form is Rs. 250/-

(Rs. 48/- for application, Rs.2/- for registration and Rs. 200/- for Prospectus)

The students who belong to SC/SCA/ST are exempted from the payment of application fee of Rs.48/- on submission of photo copy of E-community Certificate.

But they have to pay Rs. 2/- as registration fee and Rs. 200/- for Prospectus fee.

What are the documents I must attach with Application Form ?

The following documents must be attached with the application form

- i) Photocopies of +2 Mark sheet and Community Certificate ii) Transfer Certificate.

Is there spot admission ?

Applicants with good marks & consistent academic record will be considered for spot admission. The Applicants for spot admissions shall fill the application form & bring along with them all the relevant documents together with the prescribed fee.

What if I had studied in other State Boards ?

Candidates from other state boards will be admitted on submission of provisional Eligibility Certificate obtained from the University of Madras.

Do I have any other instructions ?

- Same application form shall be used to apply for various degree courses in the order of preference, Application fee is Non - refundable.
- All the columns of Application form must be filled.
- Candidate should affix recent passport size photo in the Application Form and in the Admission form upon selection.
- Parents should accompany the candidates seeking admission.
- Parents (Father, Mother / Guardian) photographs to be affixed in the relevant place of Admission form.
- The Admission is subject to the approval of the Director of Government Examinations after the scrutiny of +2 mark sheet.
