The college began its academic service with 400 students in the preliminary phase. But there was a remarkable growth of 1223 students with seven major departments at present in the aided stream. 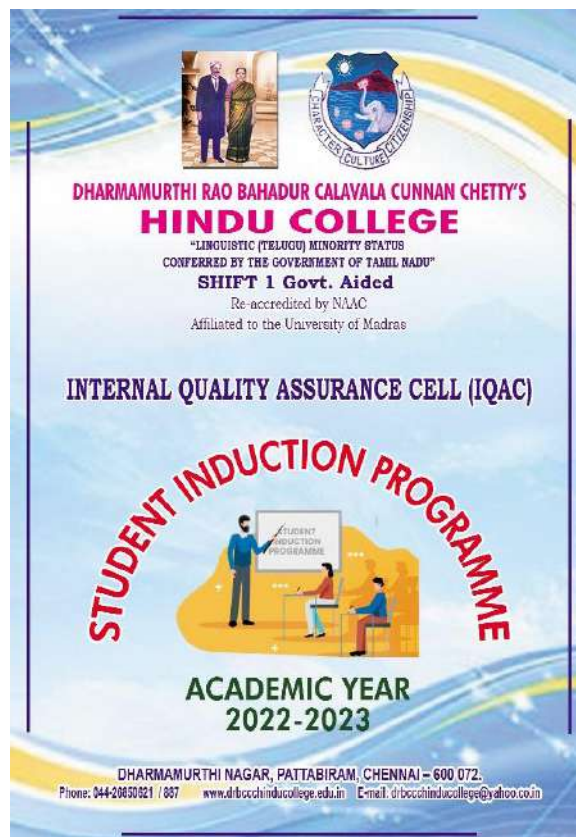
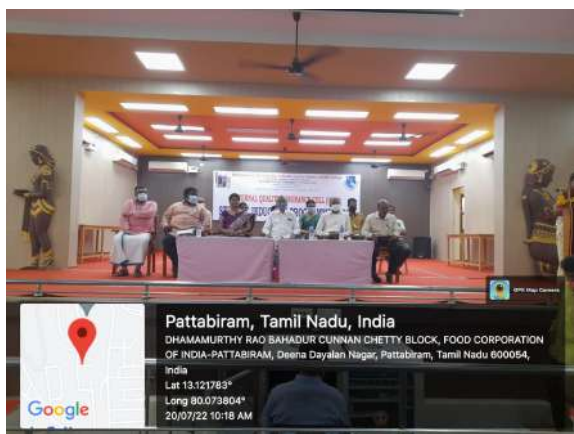
The College begun its academic activities from 18.07.2022 for the academic year 2022-2023.
